

# AMSTERDAM 2017

## CWI SUMMER OUTREACH



### INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

#### Theme

Who is He? (#thepeacemaker)

#### Dates

29th July-12th August (inclusive of arrival and departure dates).

#### Cost:

£1,400 per person excluding flights.

A £400 deposit will need to be paid upon applicant's approval, and a final payment date set (probably a month before the outreach).

#### Application process:

All applications need to be sent to head office for approval.

#### Team:

Our CWI missionary based in Holland, Asaf Pelled, will head the outreach and lead the organisation along with a team of local Dutch volunteers.

#### Languages

Speaking the language of the land is always of great value. However, the absolute majority of the Dutch are very happy to communicate in English. When on the street, our teams will be multilingual (with at least one Dutch speaker and preferably one Hebrew speaker)

#### Experience

Those with little or no experience are welcome. Training will be provided and they will be working alongside experienced volunteers or missionaries.

#### Training

Training lectures and sessions will be given to prepare volunteers for the various outreach activities.

#### Schedule

Outreach and training will take place on six days of the week and there will be one free day, probably the Saturday. There will be two outreach sessions per day.

#### Outreach activities

Handing out tracts in busy parts of the city, conducting door-to-door outreach, musical outreach, drama outreach, chalkboard discussion.

## **Cultural activities**

Throughout the campaign free parts of the day will be used to explore Jewish Amsterdam. Among others, potential visits (tbc) include

- Visit the Anne Frank House and/or
- Jewish Historical Museum
- Have a guided tour in the pre-war Jewish quarter
- Eat in a Jewish/Israeli restaurant

## **Accommodation**

Accommodation will be in an Ibis Styles hotel in Amsterdam city centre.

## **Travel**

Travel cards will be provided for the duration of the outreach.

A hospitality team will arrange to meet and greet volunteers from the airport and escort them to the hotel.

## **Food**

Food will be provided for the duration of the outreach.

## **Clothing/Materials**

Outreach tshirts & gospel literature will be provided. As can be expected from European summer, jeans/trousers and t-shirts/shorts are suitable for daytime activities. For the evening and colder days, a couple of sweaters and a rain coat are recommended.
